- After 40 days, the Israelites thought Moses was dead
- Aaron turned their gold into a calf, which they worshiped as God
- Moses was so angry he broke the tablets of the law

Covenant

"If you will obey my voice indeed, and keep my covenant, then you shall be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people."
Exodus 19:5

- God met the people at Mount Sinai to make an agreement with them
- The Israelites had to purify themselves, and no one could touch the mountain
- They promised to do everything God said

Miracle

"And you shall smite the rock, and there shall come water out of it, that the people may drink."
Exodus 17:6

- The Israelites were angry with Moses because there was no water
- God told Moses to strike the rock and He would provide water
- Moses later struck a rock when told to speak to it, and was punished for his disobedience

Rebel

"They assembled against Moses and against Aaron, and said to them, 'You have gone too far!'"
Number 16:3a

- Korah and others rebelled against the position God had given Moses and the Levites
- God caused an earthquake to swallow Korah's rebels, and fire destroyed the rest
- A plague struck those who complained

Spies

- One spy from each tribe was sent to see the promised land
- Ten spies convinced the people that they could not take the land
- Two spies (Joshua and Caleb) said God would give them the land

Tabernacle

- The tabernacle was a tent where God would live with the Israelites
- The priests made sacrifices to God there
- There was an altar, a basin, a table for bread, a candlestick and an incense holder
- The ark of the covenant was inside the Holy of Holies
